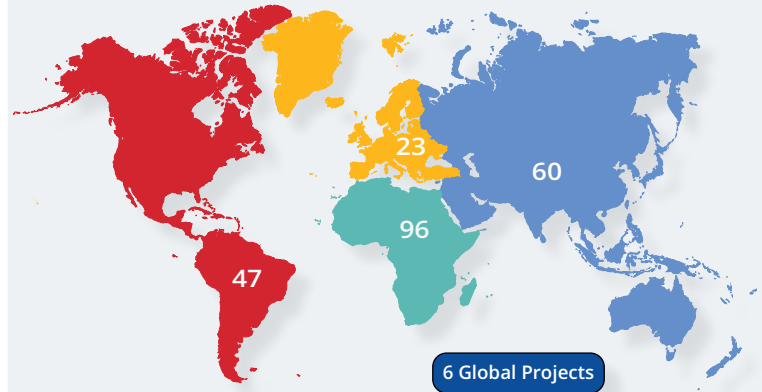


The IOM Development Fund provides seed-funding for innovative initiatives in a wide range of migration-related capacity-building areas.

- In 2020, the Fund awarded more than **\$20,000,000** in funding to **75 new projects**, benefitting **106 IOM Member States**.
- Thematic Reviews were conducted of Fund projects on **Migrant Regularization** (2001-2018) and **Counter-Trafficking / Protection & Assistance to Vulnerable Migrants** (2015-2019).
- A curated booklet was developed cataloguing 60+ of the most **Innovative Initiatives** among Fund projects (2014-2019).
- An IOM Development Fund pilot project in Southern Africa was selected for upscaling via the Migration Multi-Partner Trust Fund, having generated an essential base of evidence.
- Two particularly innovative past projects are being replicated in 2020, on the development of high-tech 'fab labs' for training returnee and prospective migrants in cutting-edge fields (Djibouti 2018, being replicated in Gaziantep) and on engaging youth diaspora in unique ways (Madagascar 2019, being replicated in Mauritius and Guyana).

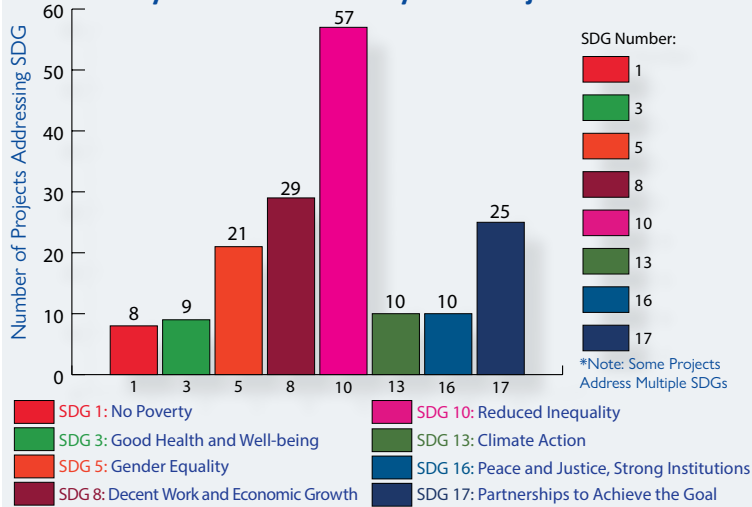

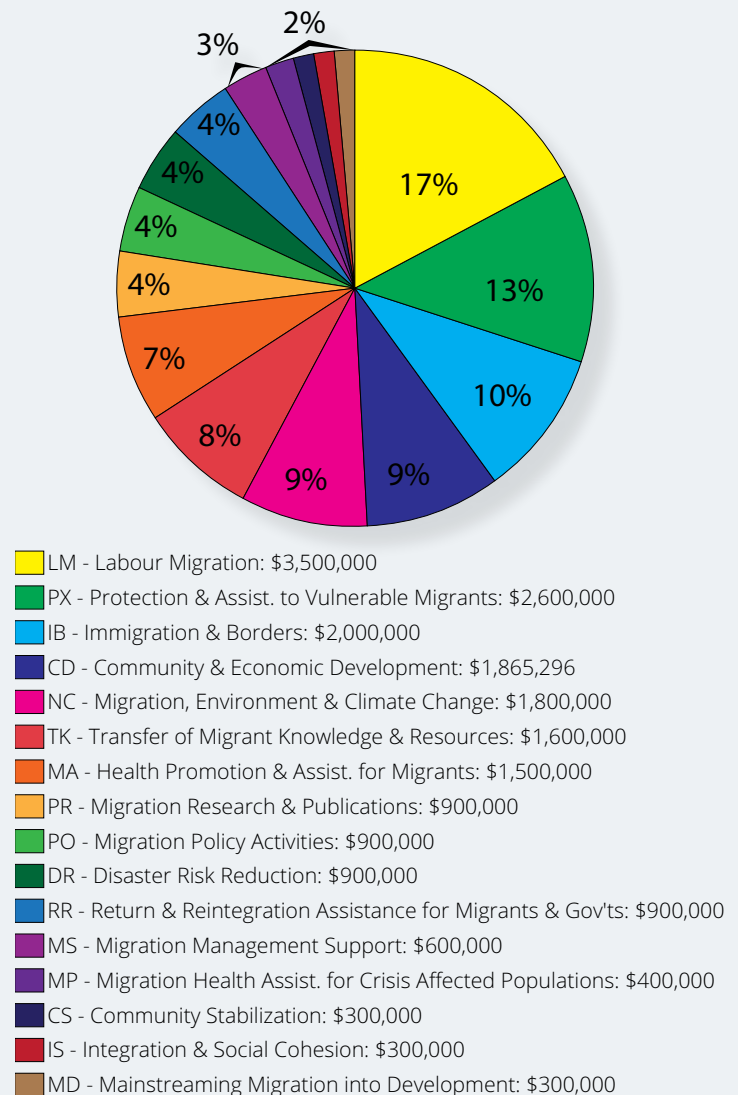
